In your groups, please grant responsibility to your group members. PLEASE BE VERY SPECIFIC in your commitment. From the date of the project assignment each person listed above has 3 days to generate their commitment regardless of being sick/absent. You may fulfill your agreement earlier to begin production and I will check daily. This means that if a project is assigned on Monday each member has until the end of class on Wednesday to gather what they need for production. Examples of gathering could be (scripts, lyrics, beats, sound effects, interviews, etc.) At the end of class on Wednesday I will check with your group to see if all members have their commitment completed. When group members have their commitment approved, they may begin production towards the target due date. If a group member does not have their commitment completed, they will receive a grade of a ZERO automatically. This Zero will be multiplied X how many grades the project is worth. The remaining member(s) of the group will need to make up the failure of that member who did not live up to their commitment. The remaining member(s) may have an extension of no more than 2 days beyond the original due date. The one(s) who lost their commitment may contribute to the project to increase their Zero to a "50." The remaining group members must consent and stamp approval of the contribution after the project is completed with documentation. If one member in the group has to complete the whole project, he/she will have 2 extra days added to the original 2 day extension. You will need to work on the extension on your OWN time. I will not ask you for the project beyond the due date. A grade of a Zero will be recorded unless I see results. The project must be completed as assigned with directions followed for credit. The group will share in the completed grade according to the rubric of grading. Each member must operate at 100% to fulfill their commitment.

This is real life. Perfect groups do not exist. Don't look for one. I can't make them unfortunately.
