The Ken Burns project is one that you can use over and over throughout your school career. It is a great way to do a school project and make it entertaining and focused. The best part is you don't need a video camera or have to find friends to be in your project. Think of a topic that interests you and create a one-minute Ken Burns project. DO YOUR RESEARCH FIRST BEFORE DOING ANYTHING.

You must have the following for FULL CREDIT:

1. Have a script for a voice over to fill one minute (practice it before recording)
2. Have an underlying music track that fits the tone and vibe of the project
3. Have photos of the same orientation (size) to fill one minute
4. ALL photos must have tasteful movement
5. Photos must not be held for more than 3 seconds to keep it moving.
6. The music and voice over must be mixed to hear the voice well
7. Export your final project as you have the others.
