

## A PAPER AIRPLANE

STEP 1: You are to research airplanes and the fundamentals of flight. Use You Tube to gather video (B Roll) of airplanes either flying, on the ground, etc. I put the video download link for you below the project.

STEP 2: Download audio or take audio from the videos you find that have people talking about flight, the history of flight, etc.

STEP 3: Record a small voice over that will play over the B-Roll describing what flight means to you.

STEP 4: Use music to enhance your project. Make sure it fits the theme of the project.

STEP 5: Have someone video you talking about making a paper airplane, the first time you made a paper airplane, a funny story about making a paper airplane, etc. Look at the example video I posted for "inspiration." USE A SEPARATE AUDIO RECORDER FOR SOUND TO SYNC IN ADOBE PREMIERE.

STEP 6: Make sure to have video shots that show:

- A close up shot of you, making your airplane, the airplane, being interviewed
- A wide shot of you, making your airplane, the airplane, being interviewed
- A medium shot, making your airplane, the airplane, being interviewed
- Flying your paper airplane
- Other pertinent shots

STEP 7: Combine all of your footage from ALL of the steps and create a video piece between 1:45 & 2:00. Intertwine your research of flight, voice-overs, music, your interview, your B-Roll Video to tell your story. Be sure the opening grabs our attention!

STEP8: Upload your FINISHED Project to CANVAS as a .MOV file.
