

## AUDIO 1 FALL 2013

**You will need a 2GB Flash Drive/USB Drive ASAP. You will also need to setup a gmail account. These work better and typically have larger server space. Only projects that come from a gmail account will be accepted.**

**You will be in groups of (3). Each member of your group must be able to work if you are not present. Any member of a group that does not work up to the standard of the group will receive a lesser grade. Sometimes I will make the groups. Most times I try not to.**

**Assignments are typically due every other week. Sometimes I will give you more time. Sometimes I will give you less time.**

**I do not expect you to always know the answer. I do expect you to try and ask questions.**

**Please be aware of the following behaviors that do not work:**
